Mammoth Hot Springs Terraces

Current geothermal activity is the creative force behind their ever-changing looks.

Experience camping like never before! Go glamping at Under Canvas Yellowstone in a safari-style tent while discovering the wonders of Yellowstone. Guests will notice design features throughout the camp that go a long way towards preserving the great outdoors—pull-chain showers, faucets that automatically shut off, low-flow toilets and a towel reuse program. And so that Guests can truly disconnect from technology and reconnect with others, Wi-Fi is not available. To mitigate light pollution and amplify the night sky, low-level lighting is used throughout the camp and there is no electricity in the tents themselves. However, each tent is well-appointed with beds, linens, towels, rugs, safari chairs, battery-powered lanterns, two USB battery packs for charging electronic devices, and for your main source of heat, a wood-burning stove.

Along the way you'll see remarkable hydrothermal features, including hot springs, geysers, mud holes and fumaroles, which reveal the extent and variety of Yellowstone's volcanic activity.



Grand Prismatic Spring

Visit Yellowstone National Park's largest hot spring, which boasts a striking deep blue color that turns into a myriad of colors as the water disperses outwardly across its surface.

Old Faithful Geyser

Discover the famous Old Faithful, a geyser that earned its name by regularly erupting every 35 to 120 minutes for 1-1/2 to 5 minutes. See the beautiful rainbows in the mist it

creates that sprays up to 184 feet.

Helmets are required for all riders on back.

Please note: Minimum age is 6 years and minimum weight is 45 lbs. (20.4 kg) for this excursion.

Age and weight restrictions may be heightened due to water levels of the Snake River.
